Objective

Return to consistent provision of full train services on the Wairarapa Line as soon as possible.

Summary

Phase Two Creating Resilience in Roster for Coverage

Our recovery plan for the Wairarapa Line is now in phase two which will give us the required resilience we need for the future. Due to technical training gaps our trainee that was predicted to be signed off late August will most likely now be in early September. On the other hand, one of the trainees who was predicted to be signed off early September is looking like they may be signed off late August, because of this our tracking remains the same,

Four Train Managers are currently progressing through training. Of these we expect them to finish:

- One in late August,
- Two in early September,
- And one in mid-October.

Recruitment is also underway for the next training intake.

We want to acknowledge the hard work of our current Train Managers, many of whom are actively involved tutoring and supporting trainees. Retaining experienced staff is just as important as bringing in new team members, and we're grateful for the continued support and respect our passengers have shown our crew.

We are actively managing resourcing by reviewing upcoming leave, monitoring for increased winter sickness, and assessing crew availability on a daily and weekly basis.

This week the performance of WRL services was impacted by a reporting system issue which was identified on Monday causing 5 services to not report GPS information. This was rectified by the mechanical team, and was resolved from Tuesday. Off peak services continue to be impacted by planned worksites and impacts from speed restrictions.

Planned maintenance work continues to affect interpeak services, and we will be closely monitoring the impacts of planned maintenance on the newly reinstated 3:38pm departure from Masterton and 6:18pm departure from Wellington, as these services could be impacted.
